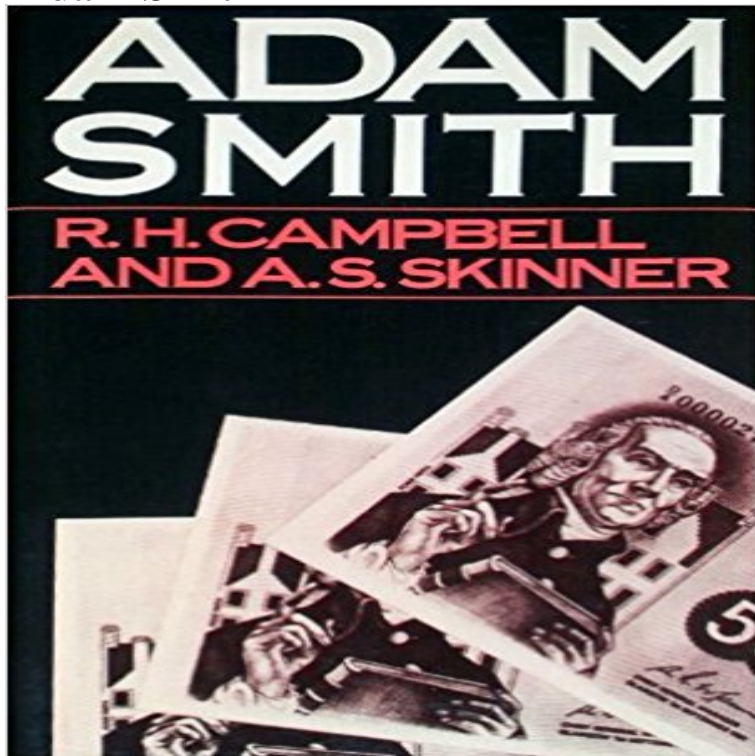


Adam Smith
