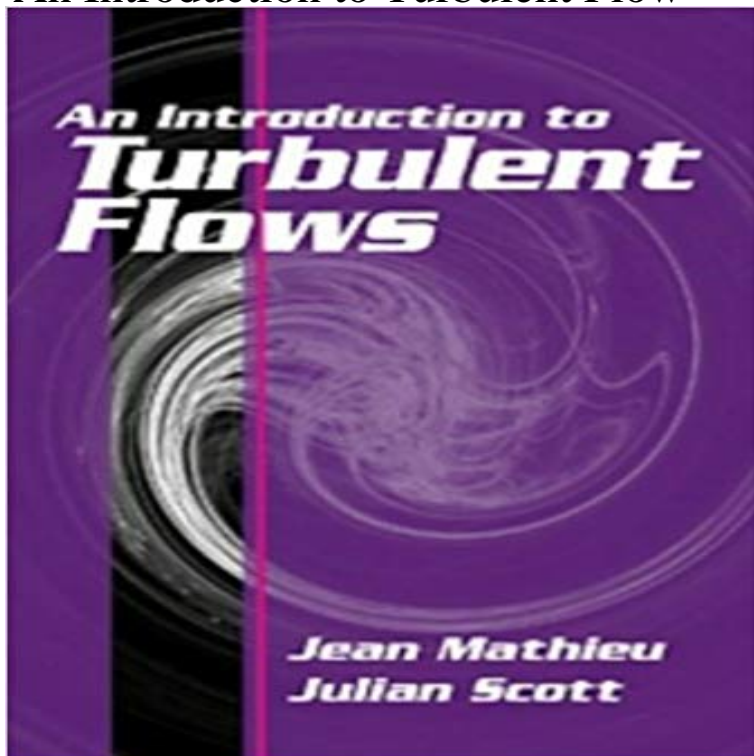


An Introduction to Turbulent Flow
