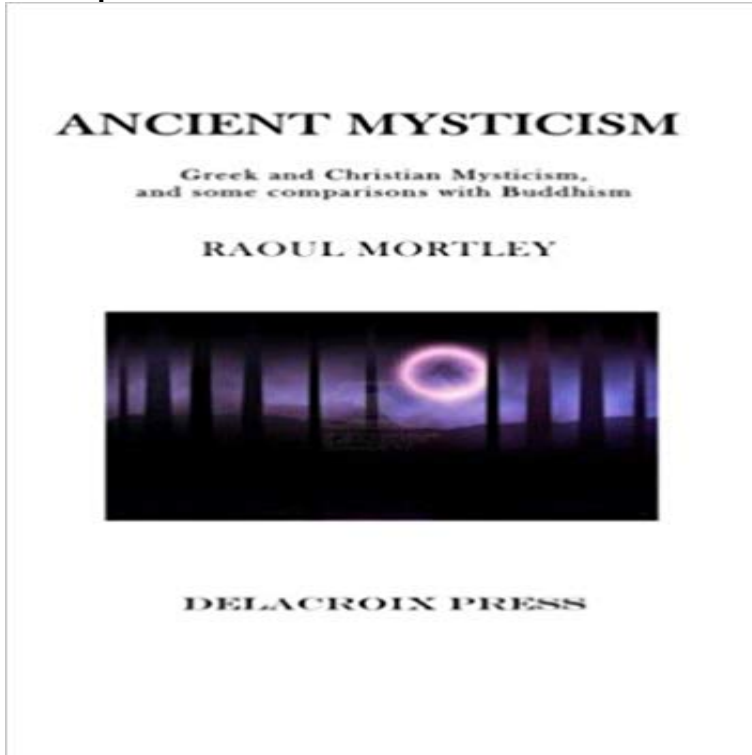


# Ancient Mysticism. Greek and Christian Mysticism, and some comparisons with Buddhism
