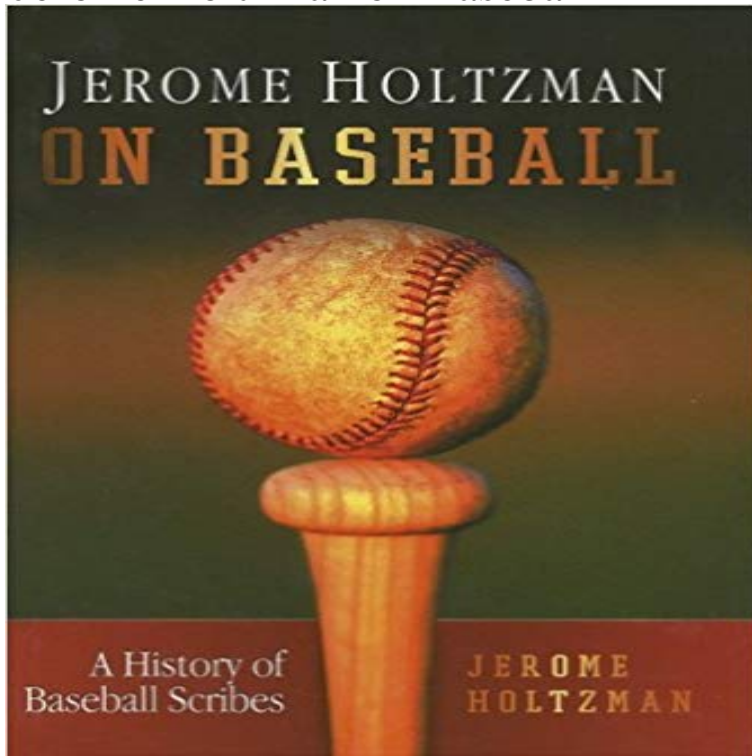


Jerome Holtzman on Baseball
