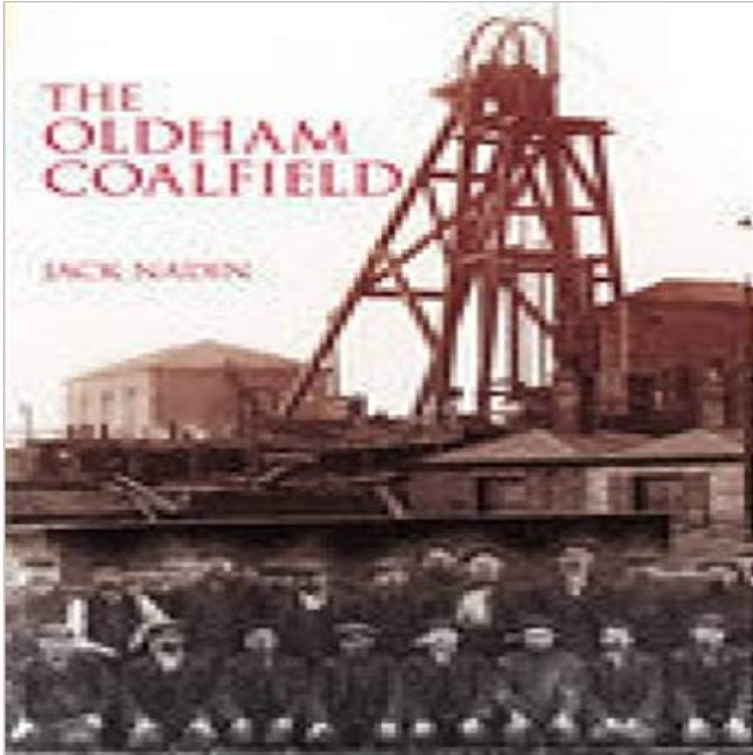


The Oldham Coalfield
