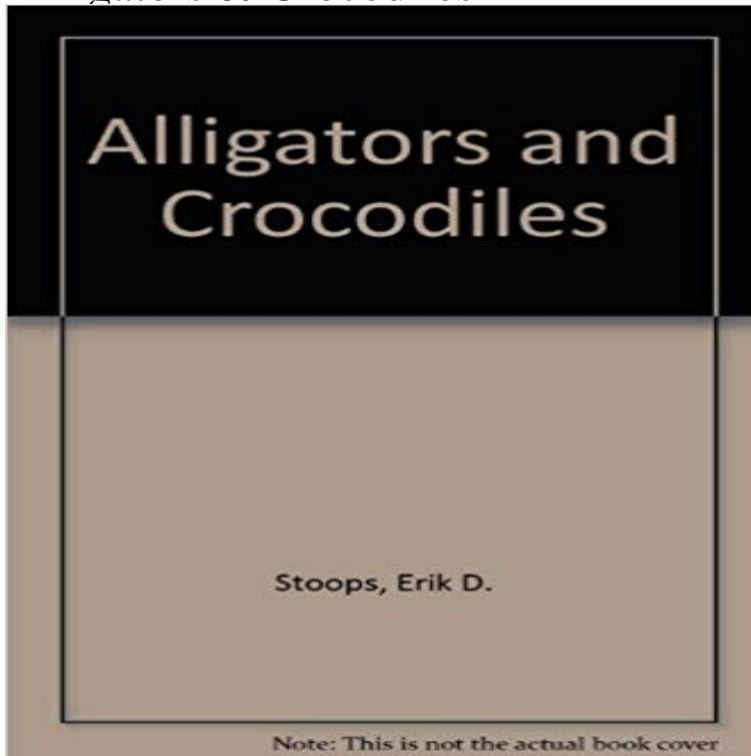


Alligators & Crocodiles
