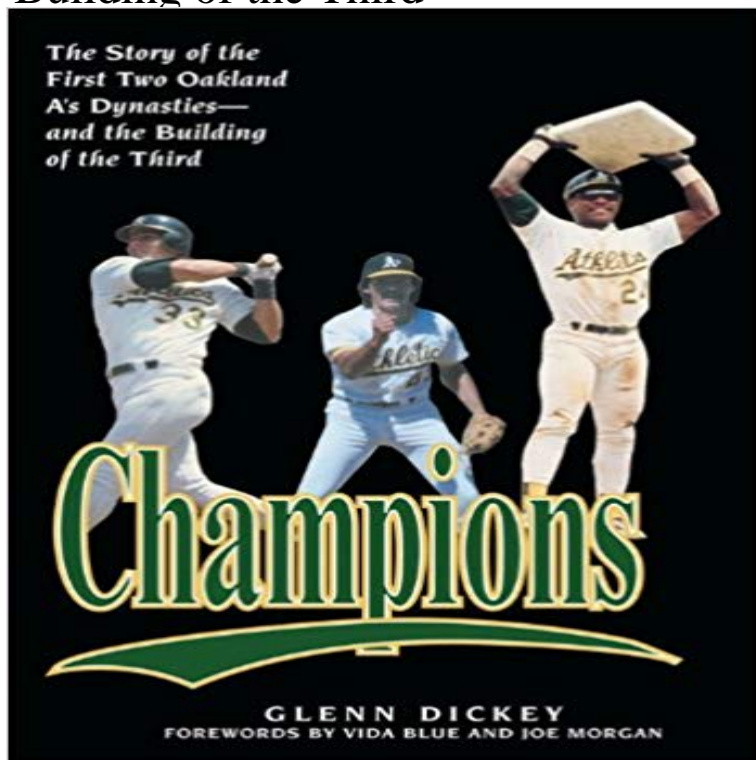


Champions: The Story of the First Two Oakland As Dynasties—and the Building of the Third
