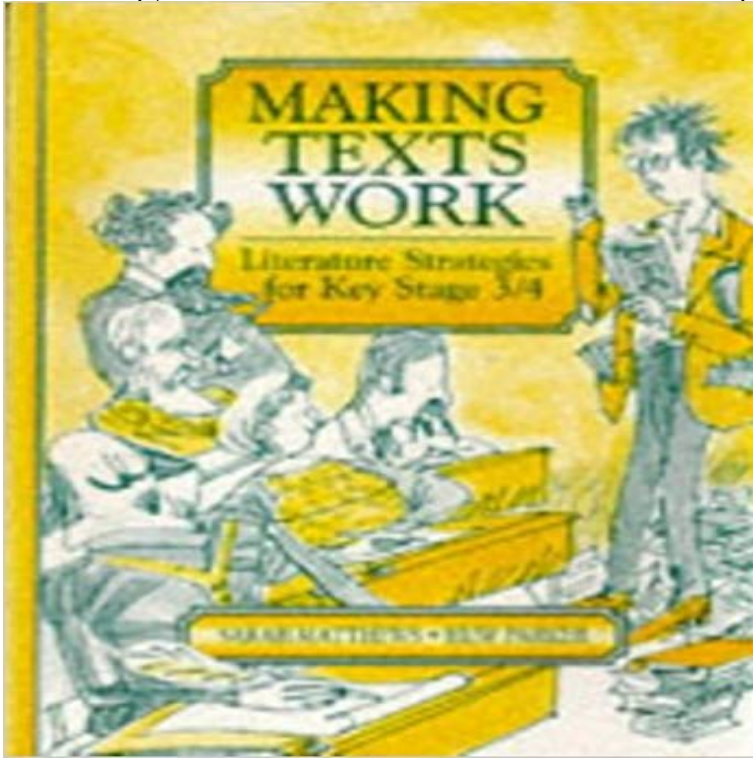


## Making Texts Work: Literature Strategies for Key Stages 3 and 4
