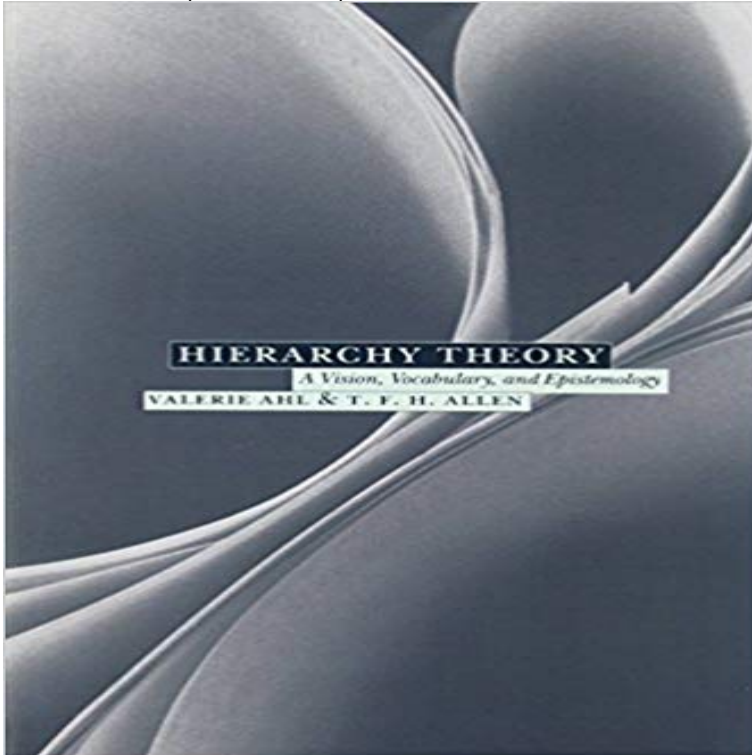


Hierarchy Theory
