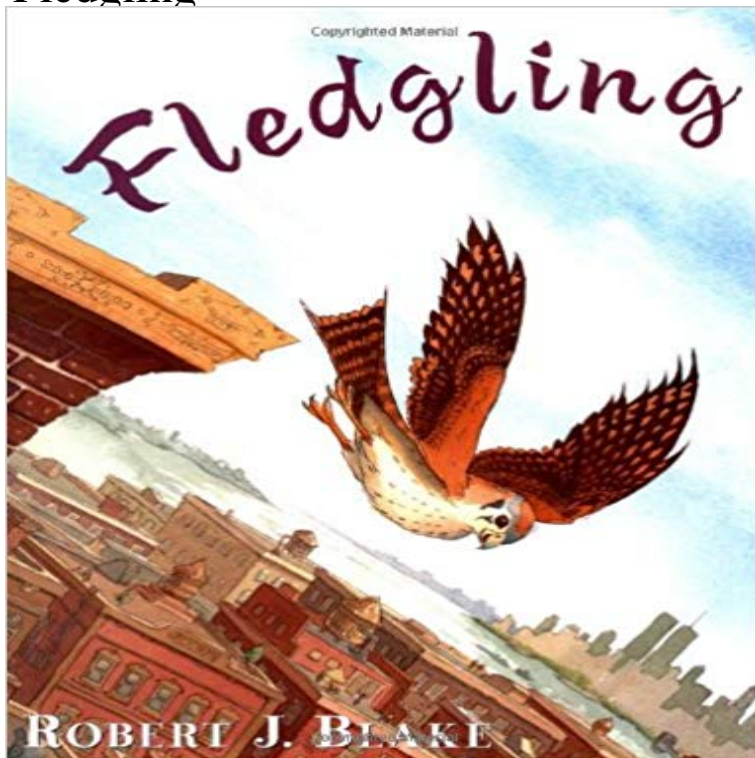


Fledgling
