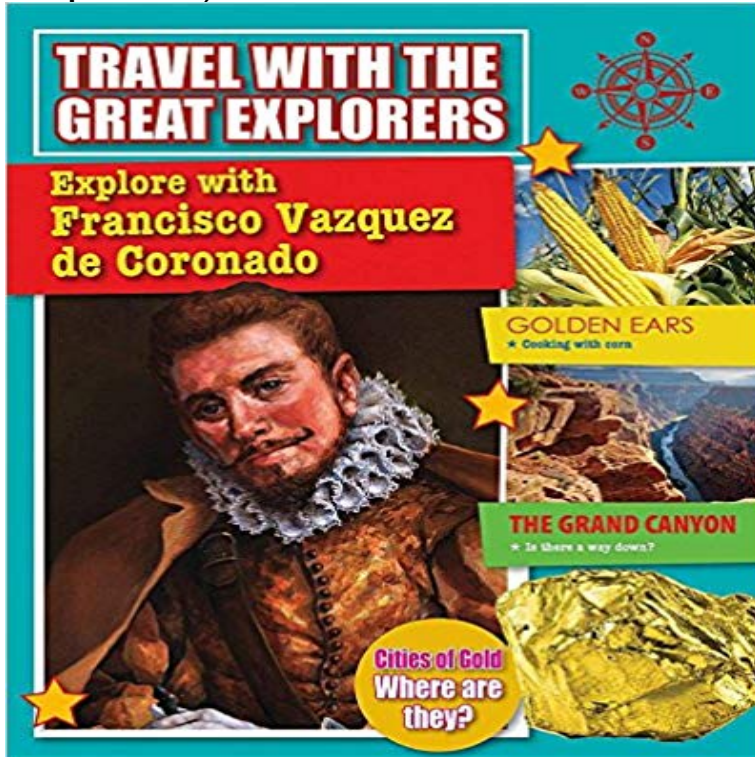


## Explore With Francisco Vazquez De Coronado (Travel With the Great Explorers)
