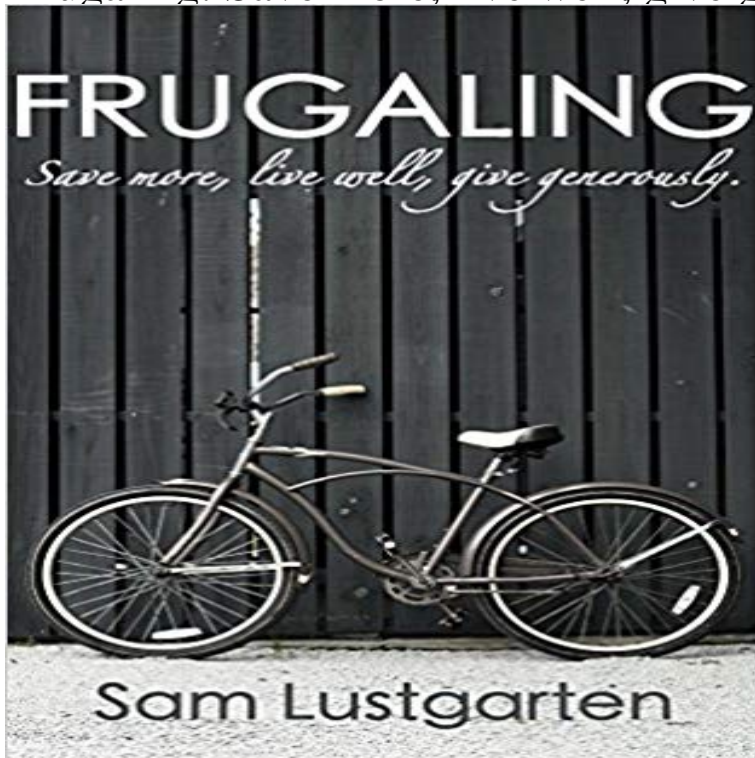


Frugaling: Save more, live well, give generously
