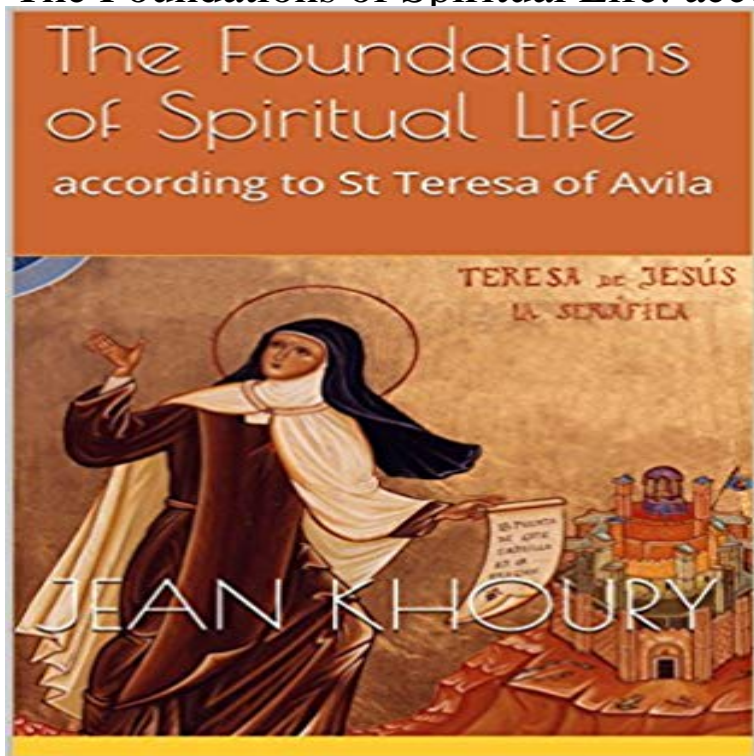


The Foundations of Spiritual Life: according to St Teresa of Avila
