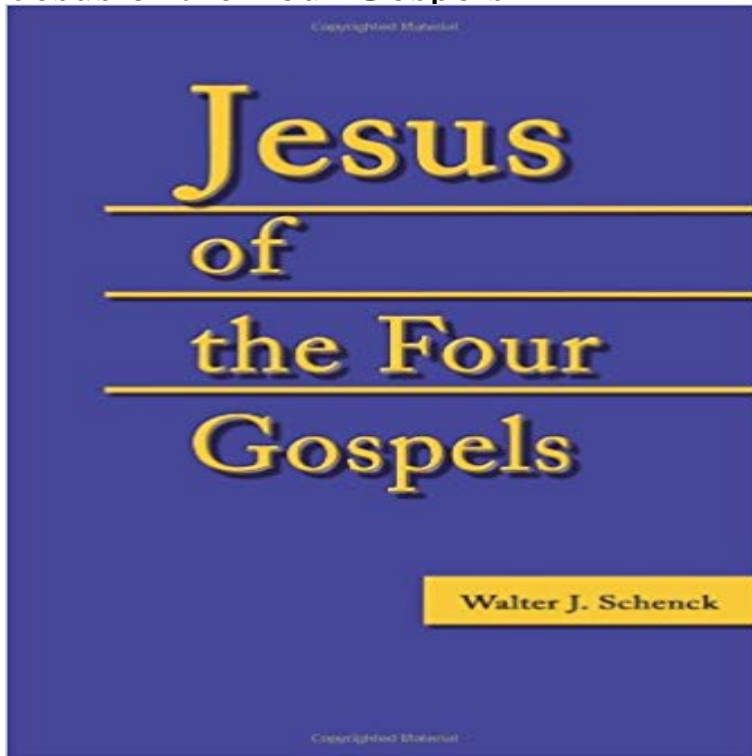


Jesus of the Four Gospels
