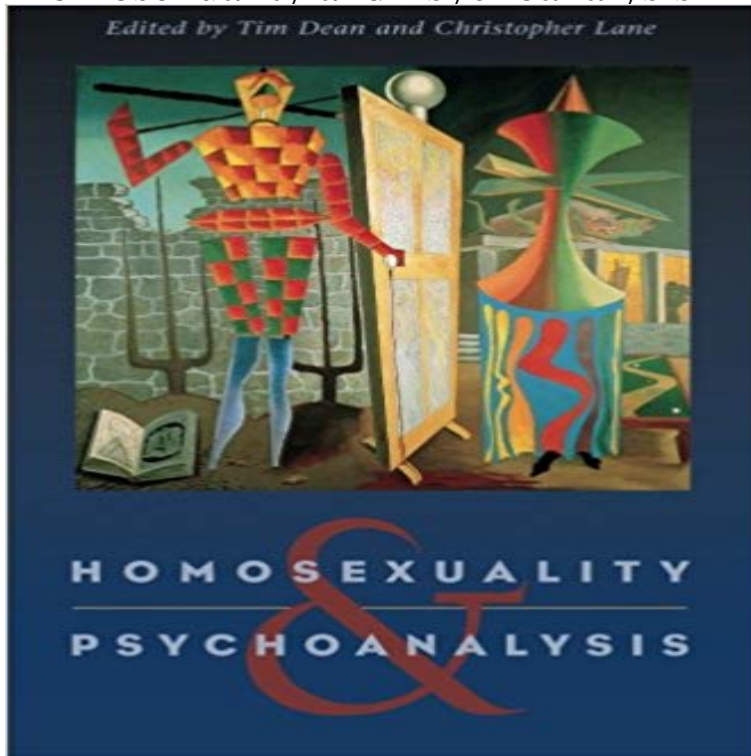


# Homosexuality and Psychoanalysis
