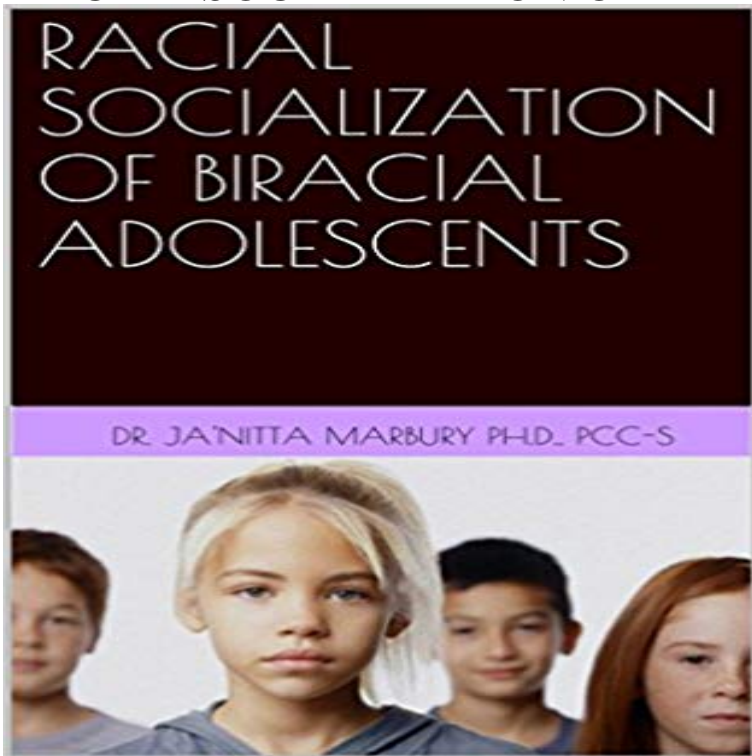


RACIAL SOCIALIZATION OF BIRACIAL ADOLESCENTS
