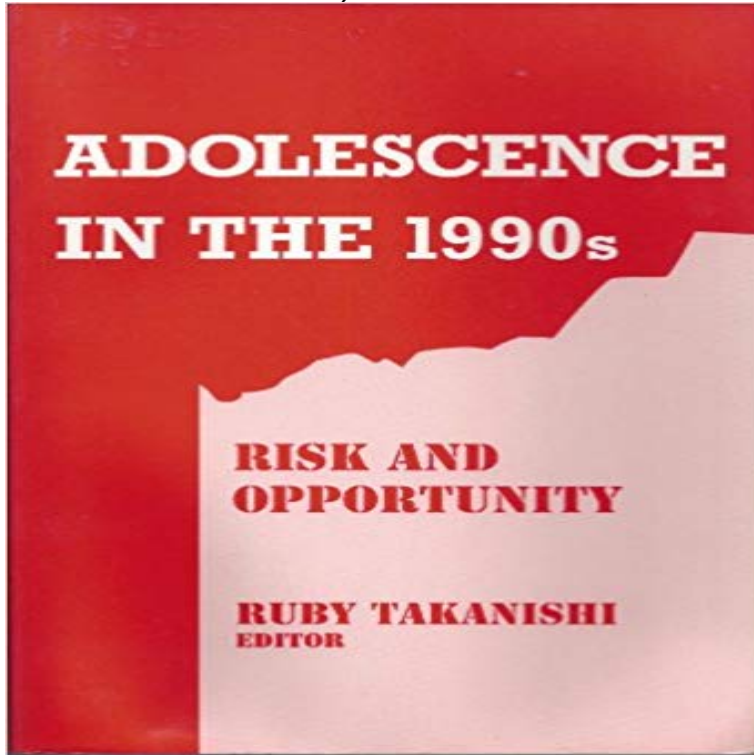


Adolescence in the 1990s: Risk and Opportunity (Early Childhood Education Series)
