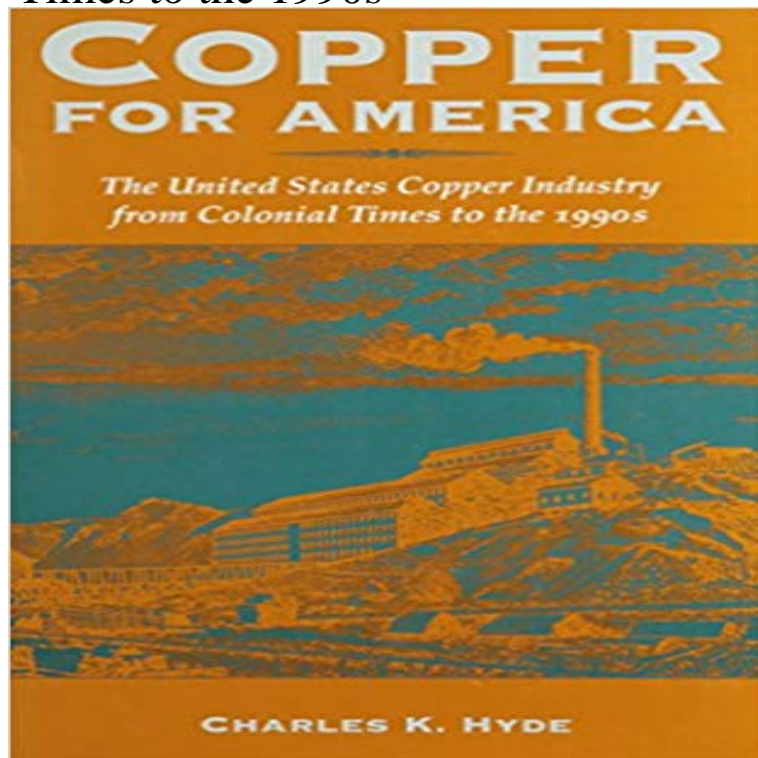


Copper for America: The United States Copper Industry from Colonial Times to the 1990s
