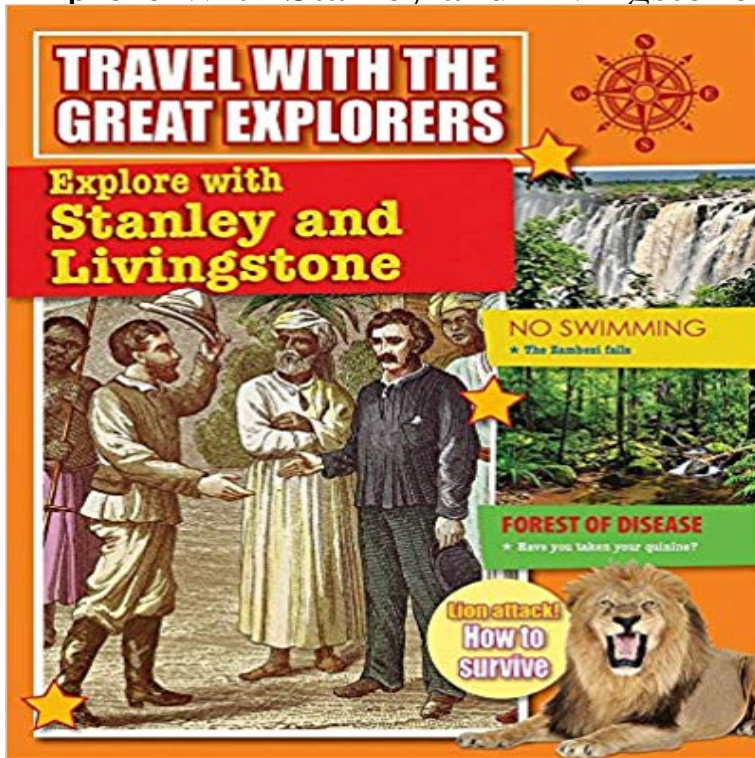


Explore With Stanley and Livingstone (Travel With the Great Explorers)
