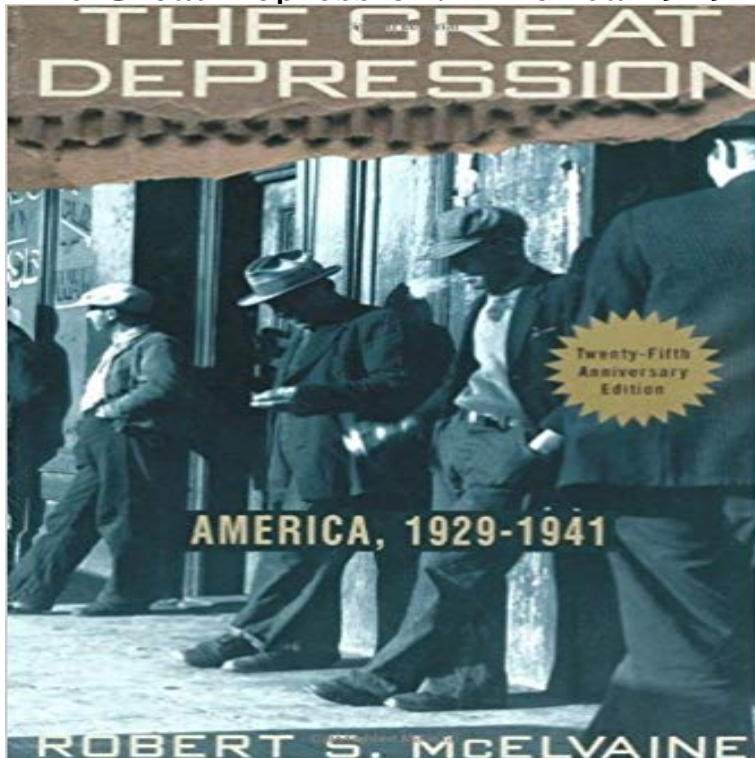


The Great Depression: America 1929-1941
