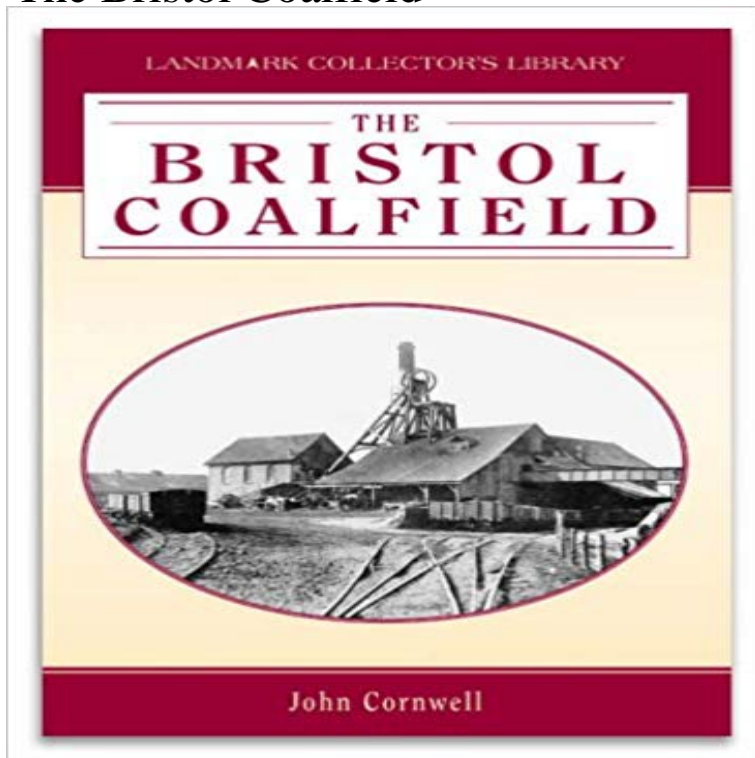


## The Bristol Coalfield
