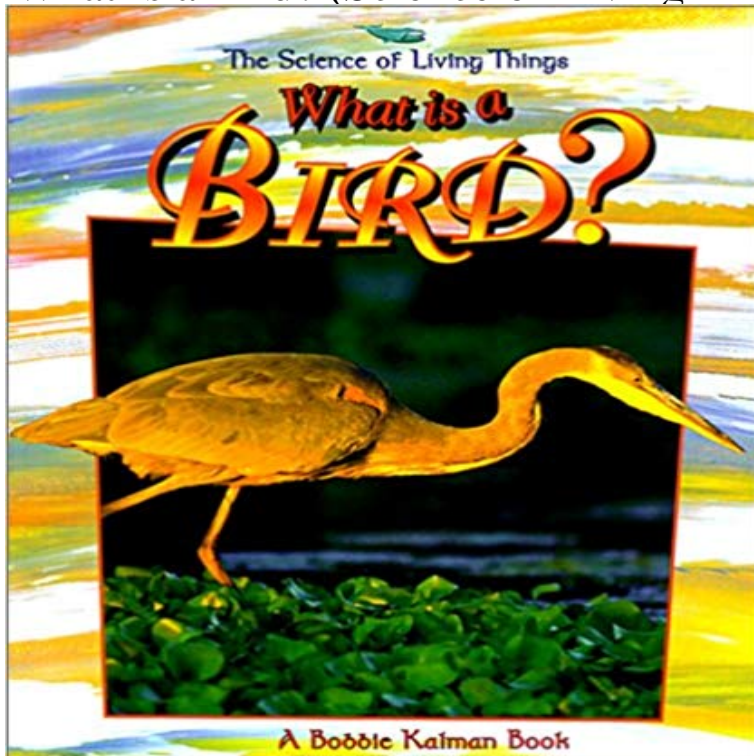


What Is a Bird? (Science of Living Things)
