
The Invisible World

Focusing on the earliest forays into microscopical research, from 1620 to 1720, this book provides us with both a compelling technological history and a lively assessment of the new knowledge that helped launch philosophy into the Wilson argues that the modern era. discovery of the microworld--and the apparent role of living animalcula in generation, contagion, disease--presented metaphysicians with the task of reconciling the ubiquity of life with human-centered theological systems.
