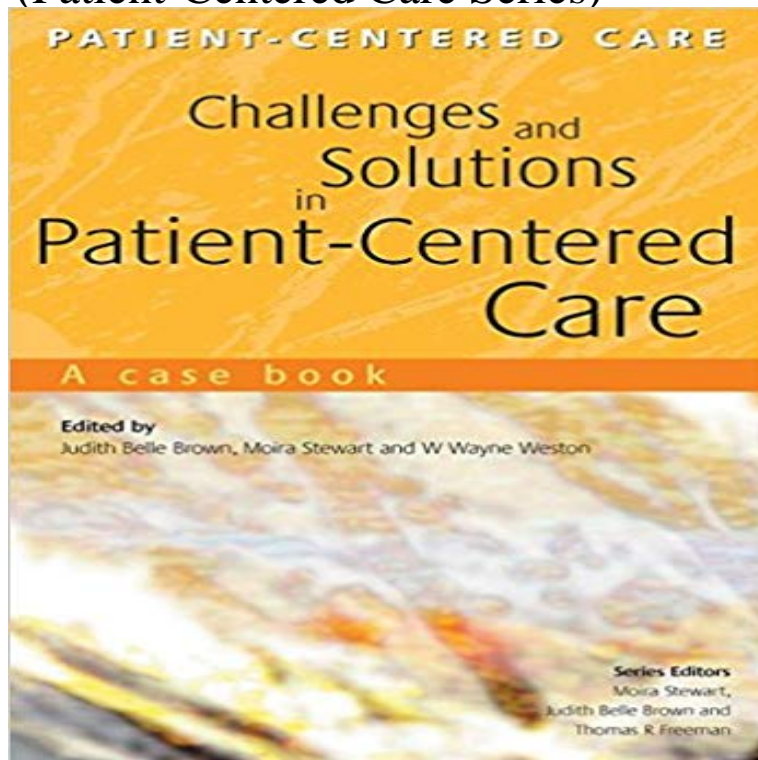


Challenges and Solutions in Patient-Centered Care: A Case Book (Patient-Centered Care Series)
