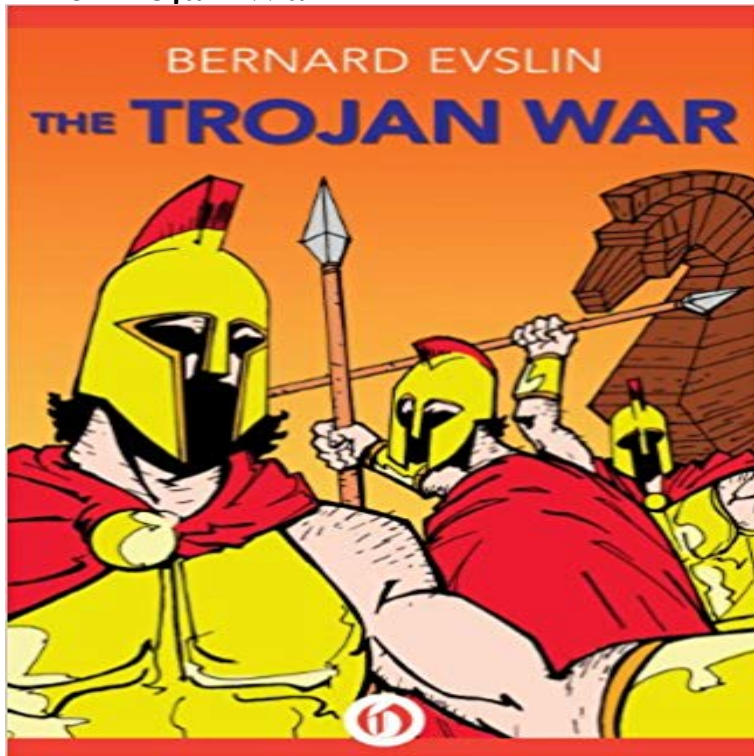


The Trojan War
