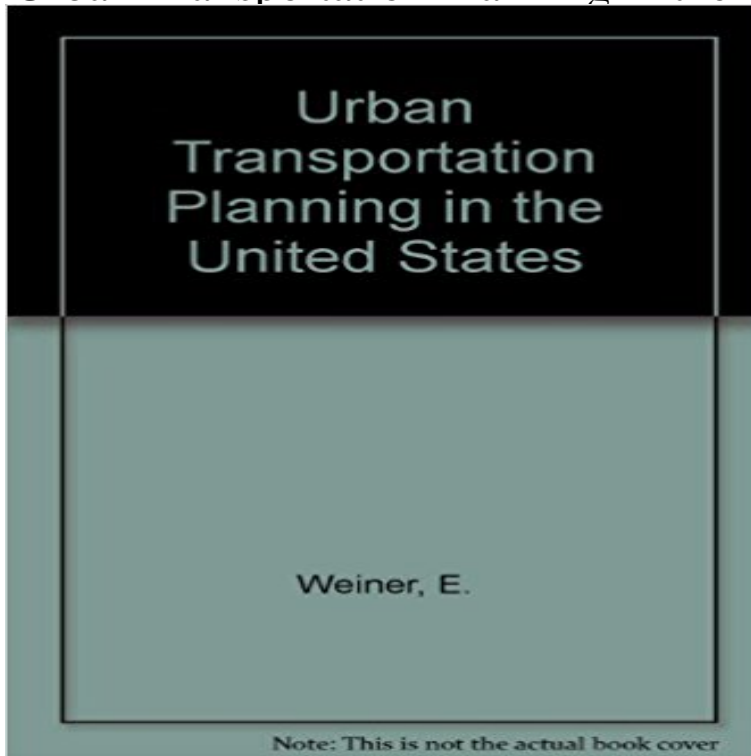


Urban Transportation Planning in the United States
