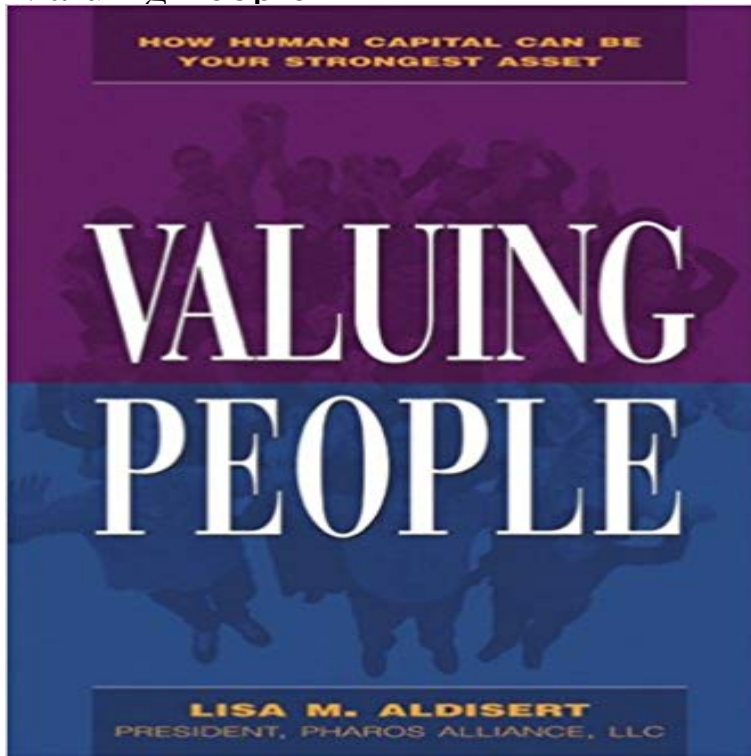


Valuing People
