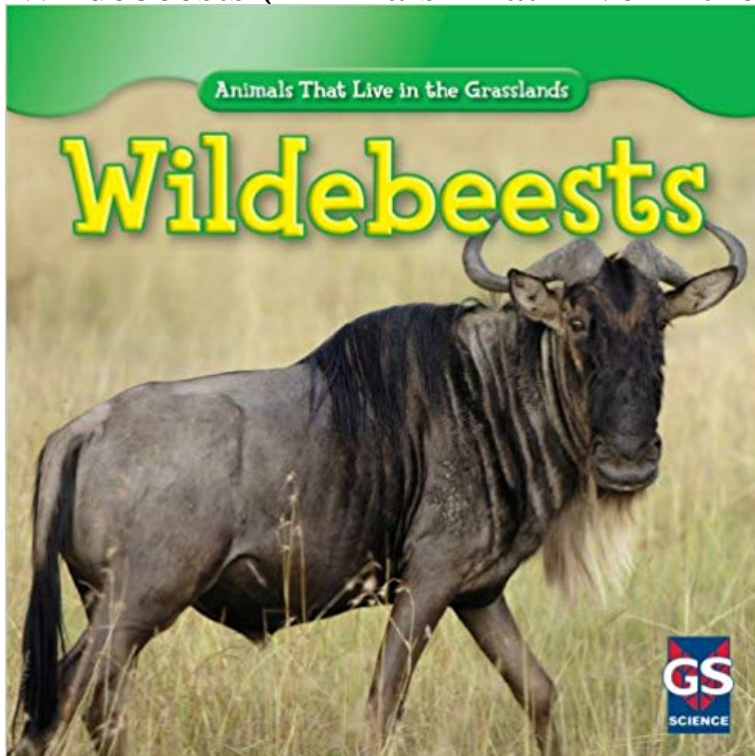


Wildebeests (Animals That Live in the Grasslands)
